WELCOME RECEPTION 4:30PM - 6:00PM JANUARY 15

The welcome reception provides the opportunity to meet and greet your fellow participants allowing you to introduce yourself before our first session. Drinks and appetizers will be provided.

INTRODUCTION/TEAMBUILDING DAY

JANUARY 16

Prior to the session, we take the 5 Voices Assessment to discover our Leadership Voice. A certified consultant will take us through exercises to teach us more about our Voices and show us basic strategies to apply them in all areas of life.

CITY DAY JANUARY 30

Learn how the governing body functions, how a development project goes from idea to opening, and how the city is funded. We'll also have interactive activities with multiple departments from utilities to parks & recreation and a tour of city facilities.
